Mount Kailash School has been taking online classes from April 2020 after the lockdown. All the teachers are engaged in online classes through virtual and verbal mediums using WhatsApp, Messengers and YouTube. The school tried to reach each and every student and is able to conduct the online classes so far except few remote students from Samdo (Gorkha valley).

Online teaching has been challenging for many of us as we were not much familiar with the system. But our teachers were engaged and tried their level best with the availability of different apps and trying them. For grade teachers they have been taking classes at their own home as all the students are within the vicinity following the necessary health guidelines.

The school is able to participate in different online webinar and other programs during the time. Our students participated in drawing competition on Environment Day and also during the 25<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of Panchen Lama Birthday Celebration.

Our teachers are regularly taking exams through online weekly or monthly based on teacher time availability.

The main challenges so far are the lack of internet in remote places and the uncertain weather conditions, lack of proper internet network and electricity which interrupts the connection with the remote students.
